II. ACCEPTANCE OF MINUTES: October 12, 2011 APPROVED - as amended

III. DISCUSSION ITEMS:

In upcoming budget discussions, the Commissioners will consider funding 1 - 2 summer jobs for Norwalk youth.

The Commissioners will consider a proposal to set up some enhanced commuter equipment in the District office to enable scanning of archived documents.

The Commissioners will consider a proposal from Peter Gatt to offer an alternative or additional sports camp or conditioning program at Bayley Beach.

The Commissioners asked that a letter be sent to DPW and the Chief of Police, copied to the Common Council, regarding the speeding and aggressive traffic on Wilson Avenue at the intersection with Bryan Road and Crest Road.

A letter will be sent to the Common Council asking for immediate action on the crosswalk at Highland Avenue in front of Roton Middle School which was previously funded in the city's current capital budget.

Another letter will be sent to the DPW, Chief of Police, and the Common Council asking that traffic calming measures or other actions be implemented throughout town and especially on Witch Lane and Hunt Street, the site of a recent pedestrian tragedy.

A letter will be sent to Mr. Eugene Colonese, CTDOT, indicating that the 6th TD is interested in adding more parking spaces on the Westbound side of the Rowayton RR parking lot.

Mrs. Langalis indicated that she will be circulating a petition asking the City of Norwalk to scale back the scope of the project planned for Rowayton Avenue especially incorporating the RR underpass.

Jack Robson will be in touch with the state regarding the possibility of replacing the doors at the Rowayton RR Station.

IV. ACTION ITEMS:

Commissioners approved the following actions:

Donation of Fire Truck: Reaffirmation of approval to donate old fire truck, which will go to a town in Northwest Argentina

Light Up Rowayton Sign: The Commissioners approved placement of a small lawn-type sign to be placed in Pinkney Park which will give credit to Bartlett Tree Service and the RCA for the Holiday Lights in Rowayton.

Dogs at Bayley Beach: The Commissioners approved allowing dogs at Bayley Beach from November 1 to April 1.

Hurricane Irene Repairs: The Commissioners approved the removal of (3) stumps from behind the basketball court at Bayley Beach and adjacent the fence separating Bayley from Roton Point. Cost: **\$2,100.00**. Also approved was **\$450.00** to repair the fence at this spot. Two sugar maple trees cut down next to the district property line and 41 Highland Avenue. Cost: **\$3,600.00**

Bayley Beach: The Commissioners approved **\$400.00** engineer's fee for specs for installation of city supplied Tideflex Valve which controls the flow of water from Bayley Beach into Farm Creek.

Arts Center: The Commissioners approved the purchase and installation of a dehumidifier for the Arts Center for **\$249.00**
