

**Approved Actions of the Commissioners
November 17, 2010**

1. Andy Conroy was recognized and thanked for his years of service as Treasurer of the Sixth Taxing District and was presented with a signed pen and ink picture of the Community Center.
2. The minutes of the October 13, 2010 meeting were approved as submitted.
3. The Commissioners will continue to try to get lights hooked up under the railroad bridge while it is under construction. Mike Barbis will be in touch with Bob Duff towards this end.
4. The Commissioners will work on language for new signs to be posted at the dog park after a couple of instances of aggressive behavior of dogs.
5. Following a letter to the Chief of Police regarding future assignment of a Community Policing Officer after Joe Jensen's retirement, another letter will be sent to reiterate our desire that another Community Police Officer be appointed.
6. The Norwalk Traffic Authority refused to forward a request for a lower speed limit on Roton Avenue south of McKinley to the state authority. The Commissioners will continue to advocate for slower speeds on this stretch of road approaching the beaches.
