

Approved Actions of the Commissioners

November 18, 2009

1. Tammy Langalis was selected as the new chair of the 6th Taxing District Commission.
2. Bids for the trash contract for the 6th Taxing District will be opened in January.
3. The Commissioners approved the installation of new fencing around the dog park, including deer fencing in front of the west stone wall, if the money can be raised by the dog owners to pay for it.
4. Cynthia Johnson was given approval to send a U. S. Flag to a local contact now deployed in Iraq in order for it to be flown on a mission in Iraq and then returned here to be used as the Community Center flag.
5. Property Manager Ed Carlson was given permission to purchase two side step running boards for the new District rack truck at the cost of \$225 for the pair.
6. District Administrator Jack Robson was given approval to arrange for the installation of panic bars on the Community Center Moose Room doors at a cost of \$1,500.00.
7. A 12" x 18" sign on a 4" x 4" post reading "AMBLER PARK" for a cost of \$150.00 was approved for that park.
8. A "Stop & Pay Guard" sandwich board sign was approved for the Westbound RR parking lot. Also approved were two "Daily Parking" signs for \$130.00 which will be installed on the metal platform railing by Ed Carlson.
9. A new window in the guard shack on the west side to facilitate seeing cars as they enter the lot was approved for a cost of \$774.00 (pending cost checking on another option, possibly from Home Depot).
10. The Commissioners asked the District Administrator to proceed with three projects which had already been budgeted for. They are: 1) Sorting out the detection system on the oil tank at the Community Center 2) Figuring out the timing and then proceeding with the repair of the concrete walkway at Bayley Beach and 3) Hiring a service to clean and blow out the gutters and drains at the Community Center.
