Approved Actions of the Commissioners

1. The plan for the dog park will be communicated by Mike Barbis to the dog park patrons and, in detail, to Ed Carlson who will purchase the materials for the new plan for the dog park enclosure.
2. The Commissioners approved the plan of Jack Robson for the finishing of the tree project for this fall. \$7,500 (already appropriated) has been spent so far on the tree removal that has been done at the Community Center. Jack proposed - and the Commissioners have agreed - to spend a one day rate of \$1,500 to trim all remaining three trees, plus to put a cable in one for \$150. That will leave \$850.00 for either stump grinding during this winter or for other needs out of the \$10,000 which was appropriated for tree work for this fall.
3. The Commissioners approved spending up to \$1500 to have a new panic bar and locking system installed on the board room door.
4. The estimate of \$6950 from American Rooter LLC for cleaning all the gutters at the Community Center was approved by the Commissioners. Treasurer Andy Conroy pointed out that this cost and project have already been included in the 2009-2010 Fiscal Year budget. Other estimates may be entertained.
