Approved Actions of the Commissioners

1. The District Administrator was asked to obtain signs for both entrances to the dog park stating that "Dogs in field are not on leash. Enter at your own risk".
2. The use of the \$850 remaining in this fiscal year's budget for tree work was approved to be used to grind some of the large stumps.
3. Approval was given for the Community Center grounds to be closed to vehicular traffic from 3 - 7 p.m. on April 3 to create a safe environment for the carriage rides associated with the Father-Daughter Ball library fund raiser.
4. The donation of space in the Community Center for 2010 Census employment registration and testing was approved for February 16 and February 23 from 5:30 - 8:00 p.m.
5. The Commissioners gave approval of use of the Community Center grounds to be the site for the hiding of "letterboxes" to support the hobby of letterboxing. Those participating follow online clues to find these "letterboxes". The approval was given provided that no letterbox would be buried nor would be placed inside of a building.
6. Use of the Community Center for a support venue for the annual "Miles for Myles" run/walk was approved for the morning of May 22, 2010.
7. Approval was given for Ed Carlson to purchase a new Heavy Duty ½" electric drill for a cost of \$100.80.
8. The Commissioners approved putting the District's insurance out to bid in order to be sure we have the best coverage for the least amount of premium. John Igeneri will follow up on this.
