

Approved Actions of the Commissioners

February 2, 2011

1. The Minutes of the January 12, 2011 meeting were approved after the correction of the spelling of Attorney Peter Nolin's name on page 5.
2. The Commissioners heard from Ed Carlson regarding new hydrant identifying markers that would be installed before next winter. They will put the expense of these hydrants in as a recommended budget item for the next Fiscal Year.
3. Our new Community Policing Officer, Mike Silva, was introduced to the attendees and was welcomed by the Commissioners.
4. The Commissioners heard of an audio/visual system that is proposed to be installed in the Moose Room and which will be paid for by a grant obtained by the library. The Commissioners approved having the system installed in the Moose Room and paid for by the grant received by the library. The library and the district will agree on a formula to share the expense of any service needed on the system once it is installed.
5. The audit has been submitted to the state. Copies of it are available in the library or from the District office.
6. The Commissioners approved the use of the Community Center as a staging center for the 13th annual Miles for Myles walk/run event on May 21, 2011.
7. The Norwalk Land Trust will be allowed use of the Community Center for its meetings.
8. Request for permission by an outside vendor to hold a two-day art show in the Community Center was denied.
9. A request from an outside company for permission to hold an art/craft fair in Pinkney Park in the spring or summer was denied.
10. Permission was given for the Community Center to be the staging center for the Packer Soccer camp now scheduled to be held July 5 - July 9.
11. The Commissioners reported that a request for donation of game equipment for the Underground will be posted on the RCA web site.
