Approved Actions of the Commissioners

1. The Minutes of the February 10, 2010 meeting were approved as submitted.
2. After the presentation by the RCA regarding the Summer Music Festival, the Commissioners asked that four port-a-potties be provided for the reggae concert. The Commissioners also asked that they be made aware of the names of the RCA parking volunteers in advance of the concert day.
3. The Commissioners outlined the proposed regulations regarding possible large tented parties at Bayley Beach.
4. Bob Pettus has been given permission to replace the sign at the entry to Rowayton at White Bridge. He'll provide the sign at his expense and the Commissioners will consider resident feedback in deciding whether or not to allow it to remain.
5. The Library was given permission to park the to-be-raffled mini Cooper in Pinkney Park during and after the Memorial Day parade. They were also given permission to hang a banner advertising the Raffle on the fence at the Community Center as soon as the Gardeners' Plant Sale banner is removed.
6. The Commissioners gave permission for Life Line Screening to hold a screening day at the Community Center on a day in July yet to be determined.
7. The Commissioners approved replacing the damaged portion of the chain link fence at the entrance to Bayley Beach at a cost of \$2,350.
8. Painting or staining of the guard shacks at the RR station was approved at an estimated cost of \$100.00.
9. The purchasing of "STAFF" caps for the RR parking guards was approved.
10. Ed Carlson was given the go-ahead to eliminate the root system of the invasive vines adjacent the wetlands at the Ambler Lot. These vines have already been removed.
11. A plan to string monofilament wire along the sea wall in Pinkney Park as a deterrent to the geese was approved. Doggie Do Not will be hired to rake and remove all the goose droppings prior to the Memorial Day weekend, at a proposed cost of \$200.00
12. The District Administrator, Jack Robson, was given the go ahead to hire a company to clean the drainage system around the Community Center building and to dispose of the silt removed from the system.
13. The Commissioners approved the repair of the stone wall and the chain link

fence on the McKinley side of the dog field using the insurance payment from Chubb which reimbursed the District for the damage due to an accident.

14. The Commissioners called for a hard estimate for a liner to be placed in the chimney at Pinkney House. This work will be done in the next Fiscal Year.
15. Ed Carlson was instructed to remove the Community Center fence which runs north of the entrance gate.
