

## Rowayton Garbage Schedule

Route 1: Wilson Avenue and all streets south, plus Rowayton Ave. from cannon to Cudlipp St. traffic light.

Route 2: All remaining streets north of Wilson Avenue.

### Regular Household Garbage Collection

April 1 - September 30: twice weekly.

Route 1: Mondays & Thursdays

Route 2: Tuesdays & Fridays

### Regular Household Garbage Collection

October 1 - March 31: once weekly

Route 1: Mondays

Route 2: Tuesdays

Garbage burnables and non-recyclable materials in refuse cans with tight lids or plastic bags, manageable by one person, put at curbside by 6 a.m. Please bring in emptied cans. By law, no recyclables can be included with any refuse

### **Special Refuse Collections on Wednesdays**

1<sup>st</sup> Wednesday: Leaves and grass - March 1<sup>st</sup> to December 31<sup>st</sup>

3<sup>rd</sup> Wednesday: Leaves and grass - March 1<sup>st</sup> to December 31<sup>st</sup>

4<sup>th</sup> Wednesday: Bulky burnable - January 1 - September 30; October through December 31<sup>st</sup> will be leaves only

Bulky burnables: Items too large for regular garbage - chairs, TVs. Loose material no longer than 4 feet, bundled. Only wood construction materials.

No tires. Call AFK Karting regarding refrigerators, freezers, A/Cs

5<sup>th</sup> Wednesday: Metals (October through December 31<sup>st</sup> will be leaves only)

Wednesday pick ups for Christmas trees to be announced.

Holidays: There are no special Wednesday collections in weeks that have these holidays: New Year's Day, Martin Luther King Jr. Day, Memorial Day, July 4<sup>th</sup>, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day.

When a holiday occurs, regular garbage pick-up days will be moved forward one day, and there will be no Special Refuse Collection.

**Recycling:** Regular blue and green box pick-up is Tuesday; if a holiday, pick-up is Saturday. Box must be curbside by 6:30 a.m.

In blue bin (empty & clean): plastics #1 thru #7, glass/metal food containers, aseptic containers (juice boxes), milk cartons, etc.

In green bin or brown bags: newspaper, junk mail, office paper, paperboard or boxboard, telephone books, paperback books, craft paper
